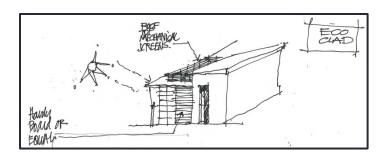

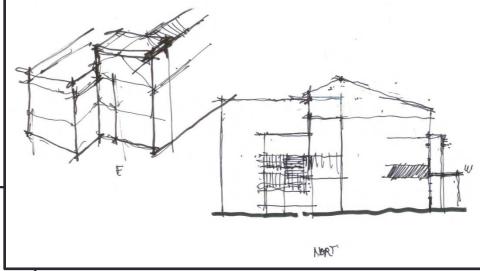


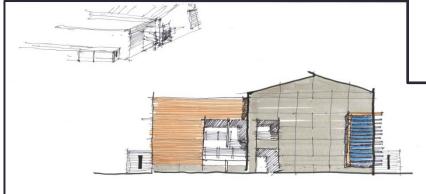
Prop K: San Marcos Middle School Enhancement Project
